As one of the only programs of its kind located at an academic medical center, the Early Assurance Program at the MUSC College of Pharmacy is designed specifically for exceptional high school seniors looking to accelerate their education, reduce debt, and jumpstart their success in a health care career.

Who Should Apply

High school seniors with a passion for pursuing a pharmacy career who:

- > Have a 3.2 or higher unweighted GPA
- Commit to pursuing a career in pharmacy by taking the most demanding science and math courses available (i.e. honors, AP courses, or dual enroll)

How to Apply?

Apply online through PharmDIRECT and submit:

- > Official high school transcripts
- > Three letters of recommendation
- > Short essay on why you're pursuing pharmacy
- > Application Deadline: May 1, 2025

*The application opens on August 31, 2024. We encourage candidates to apply earlier in the cycle rather than later.

Why Apply?

- Guaranteed acceptance into the MUSC College of Pharmacy Pharm.D. program upon completion of all maintenance requirements/conditional acceptance expectations
- Study prerequisites at ANY accredited college or university of your choice
- Receive a \$2,500 annual scholarship for the MUSC Pharm.D. program upon maintaining a 3.5 or higher GPA in prerequisite coursework
- Ability to use remaining LIFE and Palmetto Fellows scholarships for the Pharm.D. program (SC residents)
- > Savings of nearly \$500 in reduced seat fee deposit and PharmCAS application fee waiver
- > Exclusive networking and mentorship opportunities
