## Who Should Apply

**High school seniors with a passion for pursuing a pharmacy career who:**

- Have a 3.2 or higher unweighted GPA
- Commit to pursuing a career in pharmacy by taking the most demanding science and math courses available (i.e. honors or AP courses)
- Meet the MUSC College of Pharmacy Technical Standards

## How to Apply?

**Apply online through PharmDIRECT and submit:**

- Official high school transcripts
- Three letters of recommendation
- Short essay on why you're pursuing pharmacy
- **Application Deadline: May 1, 2024**

## Why Apply?

- Guaranteed acceptance into the MUSC College of Pharmacy upon completion of all maintenance requirements/conditional acceptance expectations
- Study prerequisites at ANY accredited college or university of your choice
- Receive a \$2,500 annual scholarship for the MUSC Pharm.D. program upon maintaining a 3.5 or higher GPA in prerequisite coursework
- Ability to use LIFE and Palmetto Fellows scholarships for the Pharm.D. program (South Carolina residents)
- Savings of nearly \$500 in reduced Pharm.D. seat fee deposit and PharmCAS application fee waiver
- Exclusive networking and mentoring opportunities
